



2. **Where the Wild Things Are** by Maurice Sendak





### 3. **The Cat in the Hat** by Dr. Seuss





4. **The Very Hungry Caterpillar** by Eric Carle





6. **The Rainbow Fish** by Marcus Pfister





7. **The Giving Tree** by Shel Silverstein





9. **The Snowy Day** by Ezra Jack Keats








