Ghost Amigurumi Tutorial



- Materials: White yarn, black embroidery floss, stuffing
- Hook: 3.5mm hook
- Instructions:
 1. Round 1: Magic ring. Single crochet (sc) 12 times into the ring. Slip stitch (sl st) to close the round.

2. Round 2: Increase in each stitch around. (24)
3. Round 3-5: Sc in each stitch around.
4. Round 6: Sc in the first 6 stitches, decrease (dc) in the next two stitches, repeat around. (18)
5. Round 7-10: Sc in each stitch around.
6. Round 11: Sc in the first 5 stitches, dc in the next two stitches, repeat around. (14)
7. Round 12-15: Sc in each stitch around.
8. Finish off and embroider eyes and mouth.

Pumpkin Amigurumi Tutorial



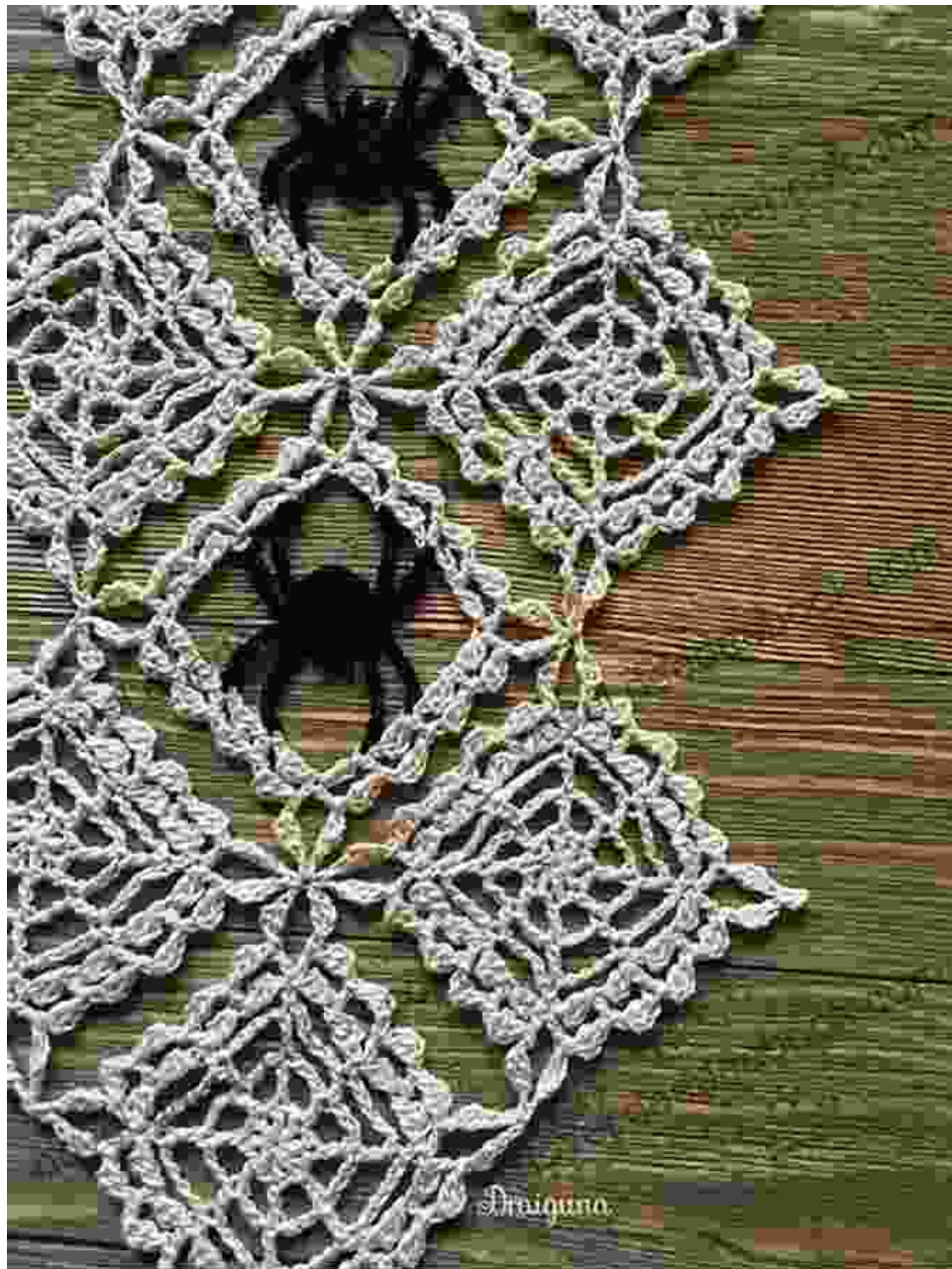
- Materials: Orange yarn, green yarn, black embroidery floss, stuffing
- Hook: 3.5mm hook
- Instructions:
 1. Round 1: Magic ring. Sc 12 times into the ring. Sl st to close the round.
 2. Round 2: Increase in each stitch around. (24)
 3. Round 3-5: Sc in each stitch around.

4. Round 6: (Sc in the next two stitches, dc in the next stitch) repeat around. (36)
5. Round 7-10: Sc in each stitch around.
6. Round 11: (Sc in the next three stitches, dc in the next stitch) repeat around. (48)
7. Round 12-15: Sc in each stitch around.
8. Round 16: (Sc in the next four stitches, dc in the next stitch) repeat around. (60)
9. Round 17-20: Sc in each stitch around.
10. Finish off and embroider eyes, nose, and mouth.
11. Attach a green yarn stem.

- Materials: White yarn

- Hook: 3mm hook

- Instructions:

1. Round 1: Magic ring. Ch 6, sc in the ring. (6)

2. Round 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in each stitch around. (12)
3. Round 3: Ch 3, *dc in the next stitch, ch 1, dc in the next stitch, ch 2, skip 1 stitch*, repeat around. (18)
4. Round 4: Ch 3, *2 dc in the next ch-2 space, ch 1, dc in the next ch-2 space, ch 2, skip 1 dc*, repeat around. (24)
5. Round 5: Ch 3, *3 dc in the next ch-2 space, ch 1, dc in the next ch-2 space, ch 2, skip 1 dc*, repeat around. (30)
6. Continue increasing in

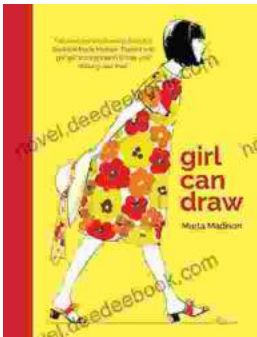
