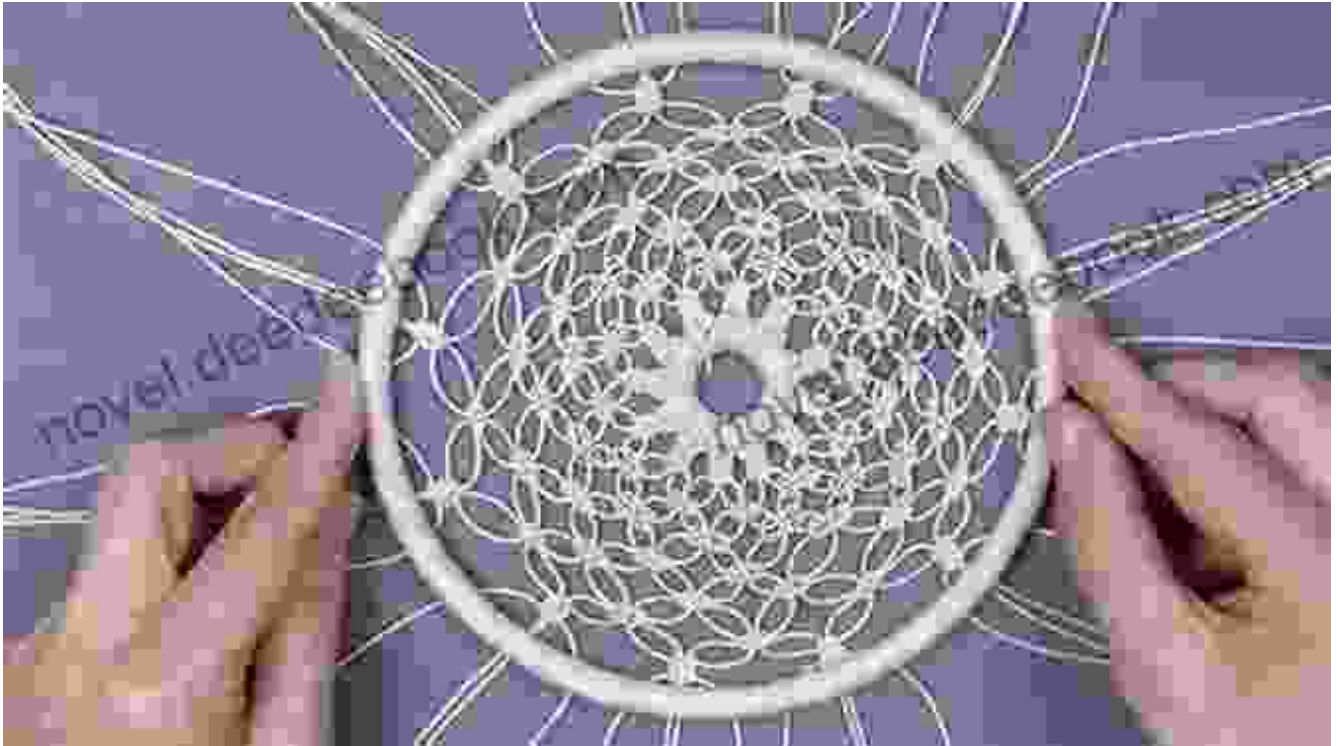

Square Knotting

Tie a series of square knots along the four cords, alternating between the left and right sides.

Half Hitches

Once you have created a desired length of square knots, switch to half hitches.



Finishing

Continue half hitching until you reach the end of the cords. Tie a square knot to secure and trim the excess.

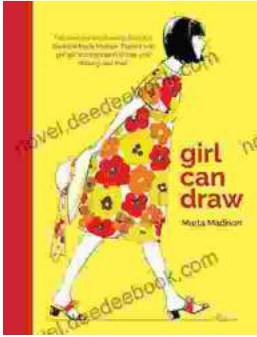
