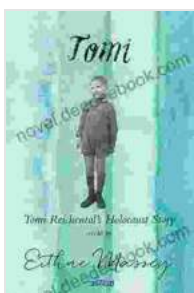

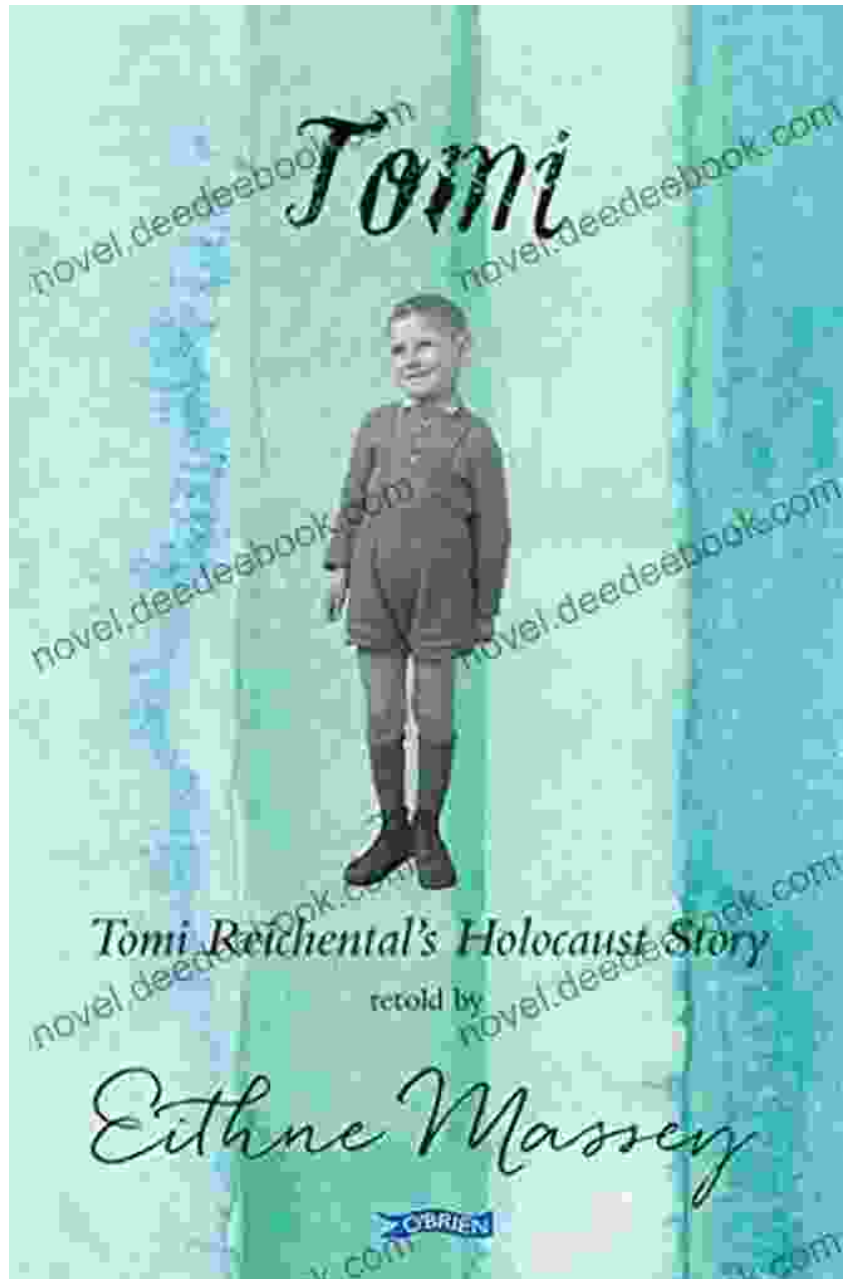

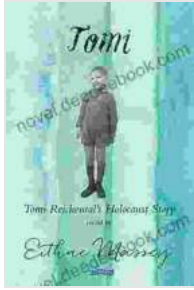


A memorial bench in Central Park, New York City, honoring the memory of Tomi Reichental.

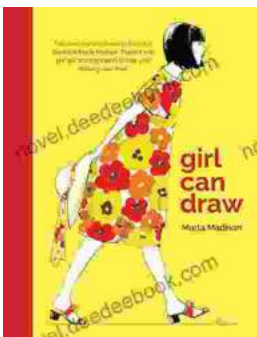
